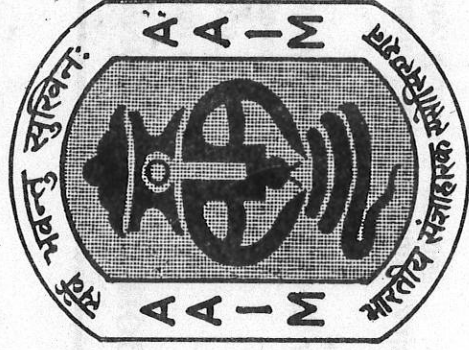

Editorial

After lectures, questions were raised by audience and concerned speakers answered them satisfactorily.

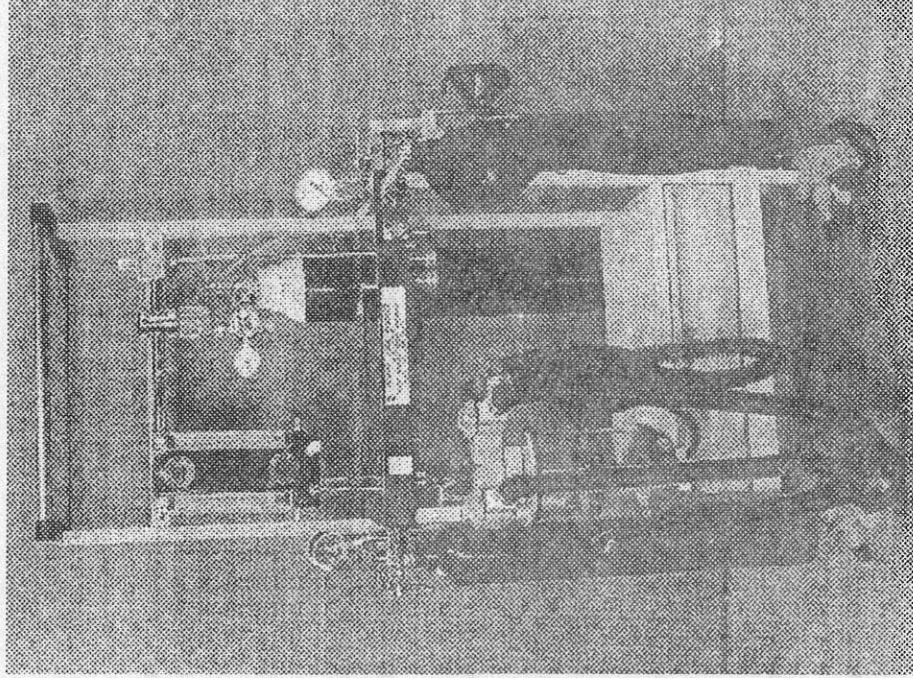
