Unfortunately, this was discontinued in the year 2016 with other specialty of Shalya and Shalakya. Post Graduation course in Sangyaharan was conducted very successfully at Pune, Udupi, Belgavi, Paprola and Khurja-UP. We are making our sincere efforts to convince the authorities to restore the Post Graduation course in Sangyaharan.

The second important motive of our association is to organise Seminars, Conferences and Workshops regularly at different places all over the country. This is not only to make aware the society regarding the importance of Sangyaharan speciality but also to update our scholars with the recent knowledge of medical science that can be utilized for poor sufferings in remote areas. Friends, we have started our journey from 1996 and organised First National Conference at BHU, Varanasi in March 1997. Since then every year we are holding such conferences as a regular feature of our association. In this series till date we have organised conferences at Pune, Udupi, Belgao, Bhuvaneshwar, Paprola, Hardoi, Vadodara and Varanasi. Today we will witness a very grand event Shalyacon 2023 where we are also a partner. I, congratulate the honourable members of A.A.I.M. and members of Department of Shalya Tantra, All India Institute of Ayurveda, New Delhi to host this joint conference.
